Mayor Jason Willis presiding called the meeting to order.

Councilman Fuselier started the discussion of video cameras at City Hall by addressing

who has access to video cameras. It was determined that Mayor Willis, Chief Martin and IT

Coordinator Lynn Leger are the only personnel who have access to the cameras. There was

further discussion of when videos have been accessed in the past and when it is appropriate to be

used. The location of video and audio cameras were discussed. Mayor stated that the cameras

are not used for disciplinary action, and he has never reviewed any cameras.

City Attorney Allan Durand advised that employees must sign consent forms in order for

video cameras with audio to be installed and signs must be posted informing the public. Mayor

Willis asked that it be on record that he does not agree with allowing the council or anyone to

review the cameras to discipline employees. Mayor further stated that if City Attorney feels the

council can view the videos, then he is ok with the council to view the video.

City Council meeting 07-24-2024

City Attorney Allan Durand informed the council that there is a lot of gray area in the law when it comes to the use of the audio/video cameras. Mr Durand did suggest if any video is watched, the council should limit their exposure by viewing it in executive session.

It was moved by Mike Fuselier duly seconded by Carol Frederick that based on the information provided by Chief Ricky Martin from Attorney Chester Cedars that the council be allowed to view the video from the dates Councilwoman Carol Frederick requested in executive session and treated like executive session by being kept confidential.
